All nine triangles have vertices on the east (taken upward) to the west symmetry line, and their bases and first-rate run north to south.

In Shri Yantra the triangle complex's central design is often encased in an exceedingly circle and encircled by eight lotus petals, followed by sixteen additional lotus petals organized identically and symmetrically all around. The lotus petals are typically encircled by a triplet of coaxial circles. Finally, the whole pattern is encircled by a three-lined square-boundary (known as bhupura) with a gate on every cardinal line.

Structure Shri Yantra refers to as Sthiti-karma (order of creation)

The commentator on Saundaraya Lahari, Laksmidhara, considers Kaivalyasrama's on top of the structure a samharakrama (order of destruction). He has another structure

that he refers to as Sthiti-karma (order of creation). The innermost core Sakti triangle is encircled by associate enclosure (avarana) created by eight triangles organized during a radial plane figure referred to as astakona (eight-angled) or astara, that contains a dot (Bindu as a signal of unseparated sort of energy of Shiva and Shakti). The figure of a reentering polygon with eight angles is made by the edge of the enclosure of eight little triangles.

Researcher R C Gupta opine that out of all kinds of beautiful and mathematical shapes the Navakonamaka could be an important mystic diagram in and of itself. Ti is often applied to form varied Yantras. More similar and additional enclosures or garland is made when the enclosure of eight very little triangles. There are ten-ten and fourteen secondary triangles in every of them. As a result, there are cardinal triangles in total.

For the geometrical constituents (avayavas) of the Sri Yantra the subsequent classical verse from Rudrayamala Tantra is usually quoted.

Bindu trikona vasukon dasara yugmam,

Manuvasra naga ala samyuta sodasaram /

Vrttatrayam ca dharani sadana trayam ca,

Shricakrajamunditam paradevatayah//

The supreme mystical element that is the great Sri Yantra of being consists of a Bindu (dot), a central triangle, and so enclosure fashioned of eight, ten, ten, and fourteen triangles, and so encircled 3 circles and the bhupuras.
