Research Methodology


Design: The research is based on descriptive research design where the researcher required about the effect of communication and management skill on employment opportunities of the students and the factors affecting the learning of these skill in the students.

Analysis: The study analysis was done using MS Excel and the hypothesis testing was done by driving the correlation between the variables.


Data Analysis

1. What is your gender?




Around 65% male and 35% female student participated in the survey.

2. Communication is one of the crucial employability skills that are most required in the current era of interconnected work environment.




Most of the student comprehend that communication is one of the important skills required for the employment opportunities.

Communication and management skill are the need of the hour as per the result of the survey.


4. Skills like managing team and plans are necessary in present day context for getting job.

5. What are the causes affecting the skill development of the students?


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Lack of self-management skill to and communication skill are one of the common factors affecting the skill development of students

H1: There is significant effect of communication and management skill on employment




