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# Impacts Of Social Media On Academic Performance And Teaching Learning Process-A Systematic Review Of The Recent Research

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**Abstract-** Social media nowadays plays a significant role on the lifestyles of young generation. It is a means to interact with people, facilitates the sharing of ideas, Information and thoughts by building strong social networks. It is not only limited till entertainments and Informational purposes Social Media has proven its beneficial role in education domain and process. This study tried to highlight the ramifications of social communication on educational prospective of scholars and also some factors related to it. The objective of this paper is to find the gap from a systematic review of literature. Current study through various reviews of literature has tried to produce an understanding of social sites in relation to( educational procedure, transmission and cooperation, scholastic progress ) (LMS-Learning Management System),their use in secondary education. This investigation was carried out according to present reporting items for systematic review and Meta Analyses (PRISMA) guidelines.

The conclusion reveals the positive repercussions of social network on educational attainment of scholars including all surpassing aspects, hence recommending that usage of social sites in higher educational domains is fairly beneficial for the students. But, the educator community and specially the academic schools are still not triggered their work in line with the usage of social networking sites.

## Introduction

Online social networks nowadays have played a significant role in our lifestyles since last decade it has changed our daily routine tremendously. These have managed to change the lifestyles of young generation by giving them an enriched way for communication and entertainment.

On the other hand, educational sectors considered the use of social networking sites as main reason for decreasing students' interest in education and academics thus resulting in dropouts.

Academic domains did not turn up with the open ended solutions for the ceaseless dropping down of the delight, enthusiasm of the students towards their intellectual growth ,although numerous solutions have been considered so far.

Learning by doing , Blended approach and instructional guidance have been initiated to increase awareness among the students and connecting them to educational process. Social media supports these patterns as these are the most enjoyable source of gathering knowledge and information for the students.

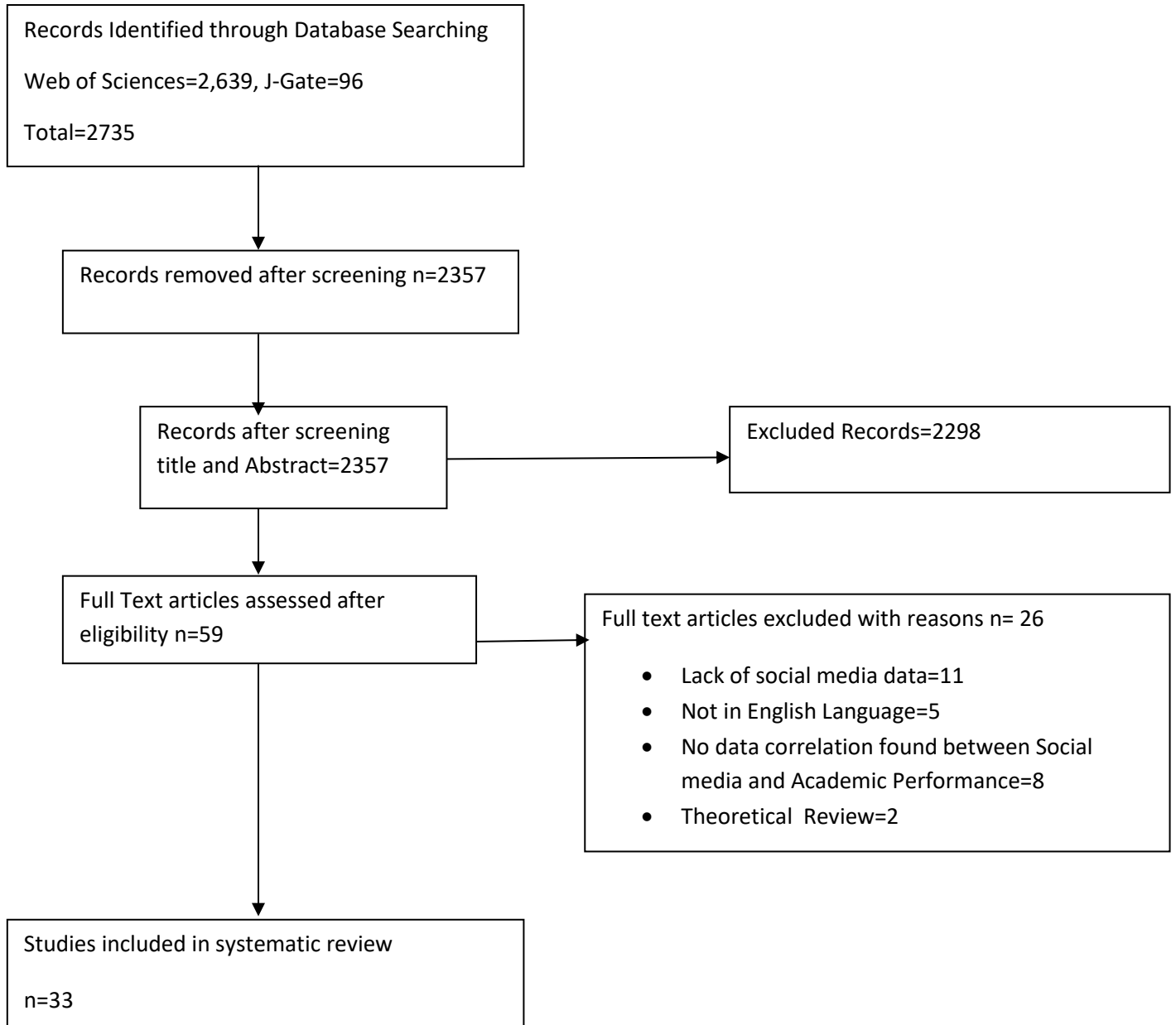

### **Social Communication and its Impact on Academic Domains**

In this study review of the studies has been done which revealed the impact of OSNs on education and academic achievement of students especially senior secondary students.59 papers that have been published from 2004 onwards were collected and studied and it was found that OSNs have positive impact on Academic performance of senior secondary students.

## Evidence Synthesis

### Search Results

In initial search 2,735 publications were identified, of which 59 met inclusion criteria for full text review. Of these, 33 publications were obtained for outcomes of the result. Characteristics of the studies which were included can be found in Table1.

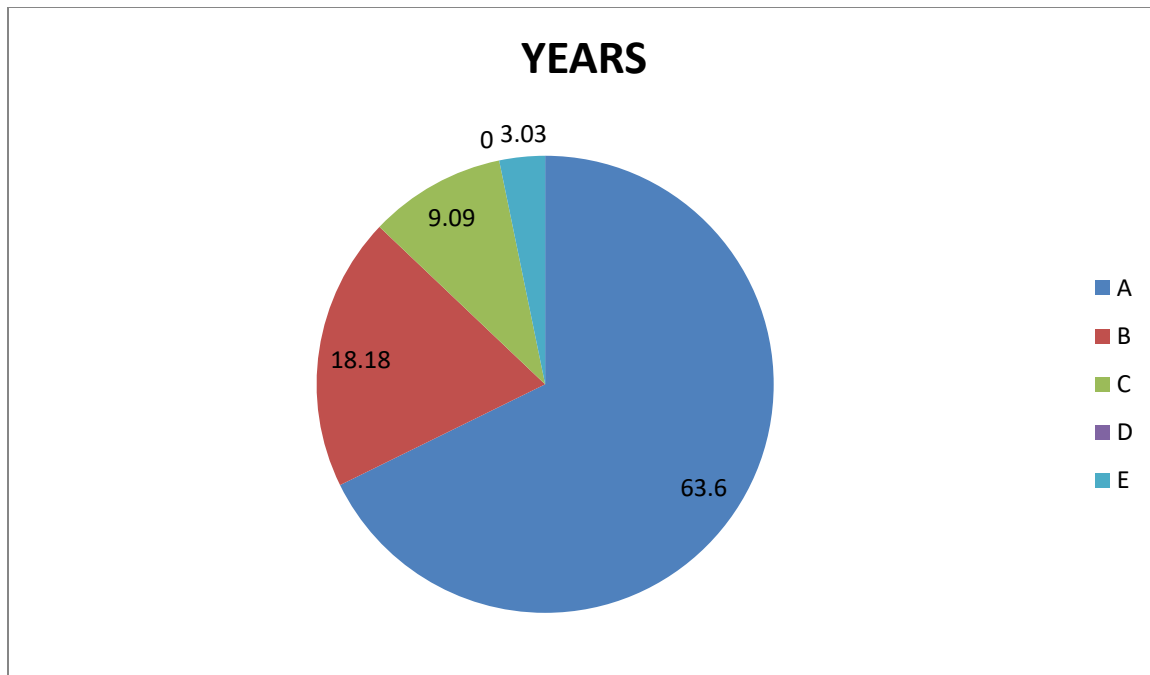

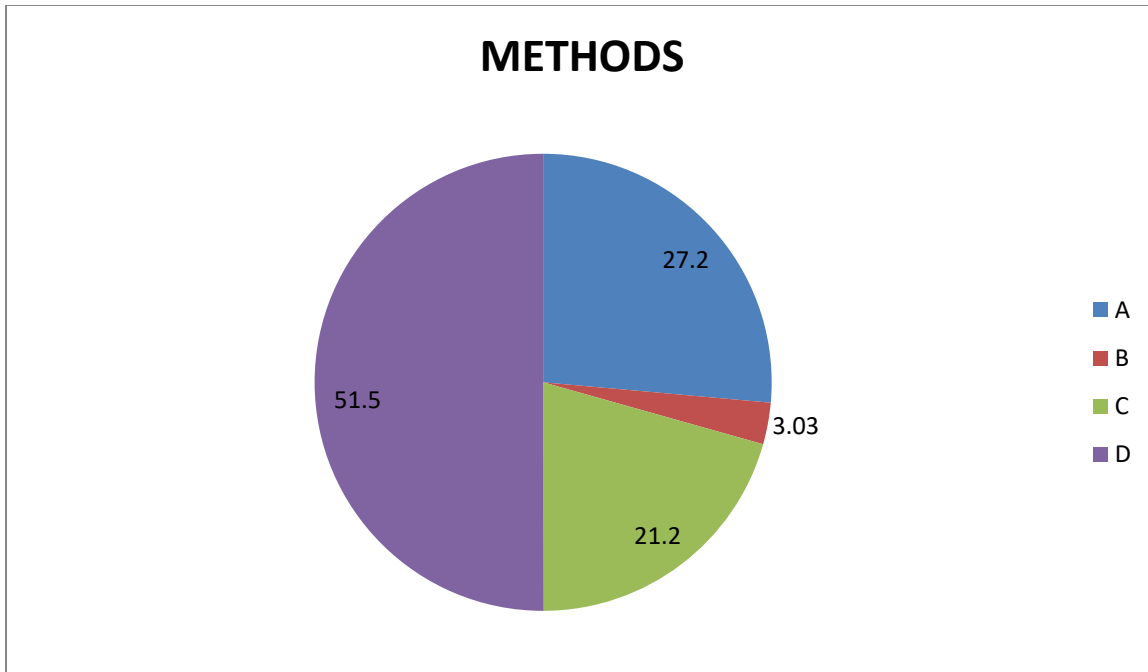
## Results and Discussions

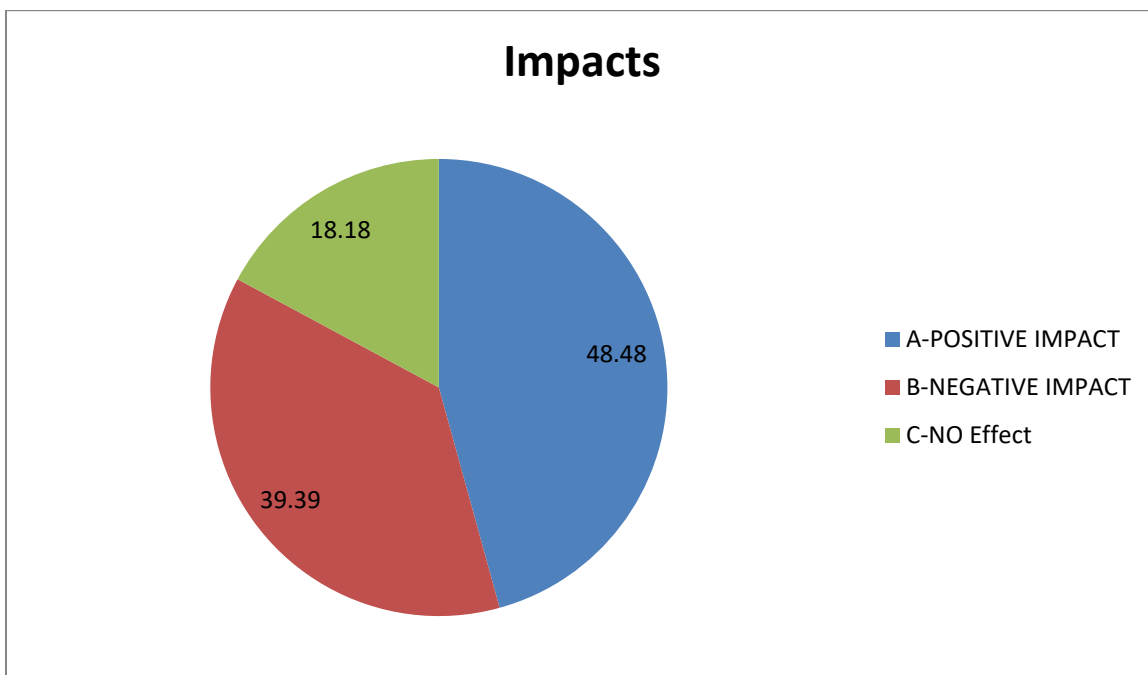
The result were as follows-
