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## College Library Services In ICT Environment With Special Reference To Golaghat District Of Assam

In the present age libraries are considered as knowledge resource centers. In recent times, application of Information Communication and Technology has brought great changes in functioning of college libraries. At present, the college library has been maintaining two parallel collections of reading materials such as traditional that is print and electronic resources to satisfy the varied needs of the user community. This paper describes the overall changes in the field of college library by the advent of ICT. The present study is based on primary and secondary data. The secondary data includes published documents and books and journals etc. The data will be analysis to drawn the conclusion. This paper highlights problem and prospects of adoption and absorption of ICT in college library of Golaghat District.

### 1. Introduction:

## 6. Data Analysis

Educational Institution in Golaghat District: Golaghat district is situated in upper Assam. The total population of Golaghat District is 10, 66888 and literacy rate 78.31%. It has seen that male literacy rate 84.20% and female literacy rate 72.18 % (Economic & Statistical 2011 Census Report). Golaghat District have 23 provincialized School, 01 Govt. Higher Secondary School, 04 Junior College (provincialized), 7 Junior College (Concurrence), 121 Provincialized High School, 32 Govt. Recognized High School, 45 Non provincialized School (Report as IAS Office 2013). I have selected five provincialized college libraries of Golaghat District for survey.

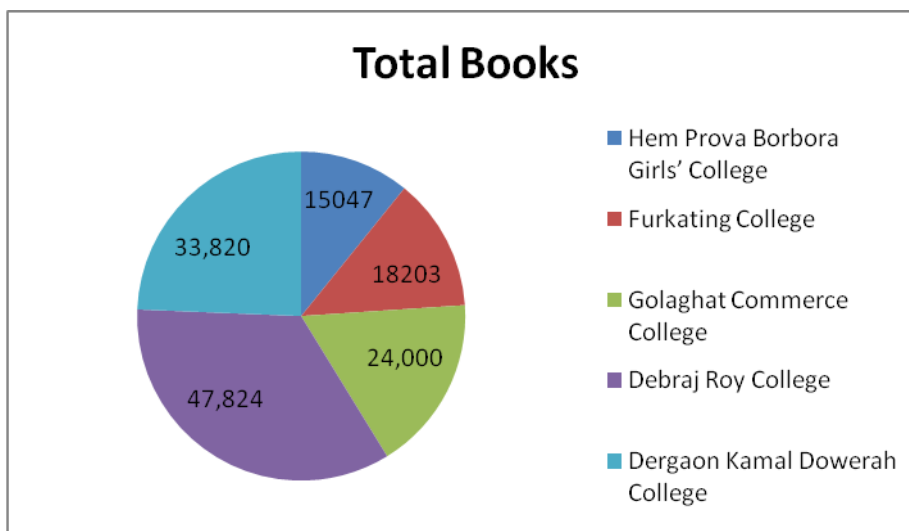

**Fig 1: Total Books**

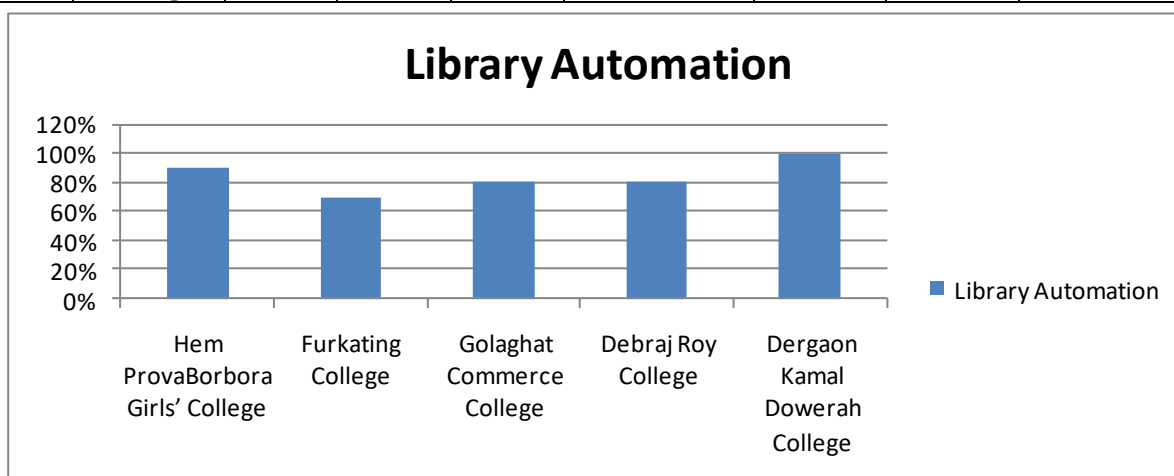

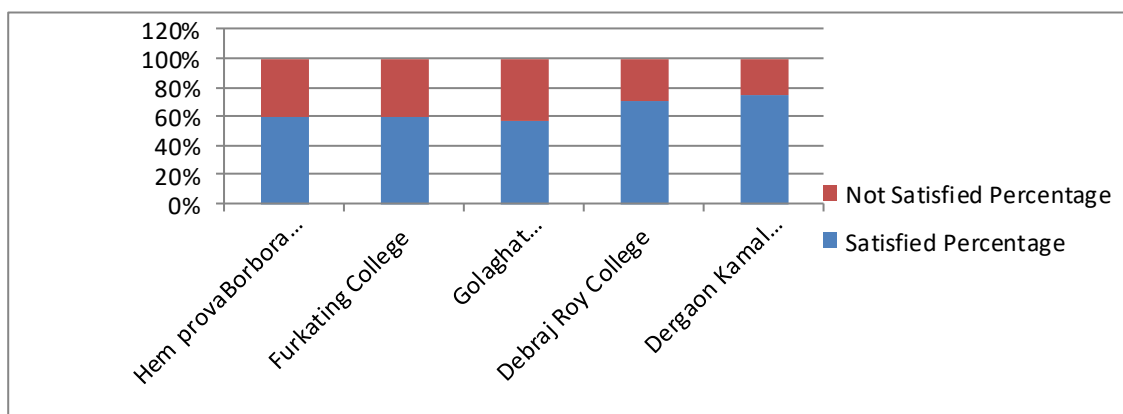
**Fig 2: Library Automation Status**

## 8. Findings:

Packages is so user friendly. In survey we have seen that DKD College has performed all the services of SOUL Software.

In this survey it is known that all colleges have N-list membership of INFLIBNET. They can access large amount of scholarly journal. Users are getting opportunity to develop their scholarly activities through them. Some college has not maintained their institutional repository for users in the College library.

Colleges like Debraj Roy College and DKD College have more than thirty thousand collections in its library but other colleges like Furkating College, Golaghat Commerce College and H.P.B. College is less than thirty thousand. Some college libraries have very a smaller number of journals and newspapers.

From the survey it is found that most of the college libraries of Golaghat District are providing facilities like open access, circulation, reference service, new book display and book bank to its users. The number of three colleges has very few numbers of staff. Through the users' survey it is found that most of the users are not satisfied with their library collection. The users of DKD College library and Debraj Roy College library are more satisfied with the library facilities and the users of Golaghat Commerce College and other two college library are least satisfied with the services of libraries. College library has used the barcode scanner in their library activities. It is also found that users are more comfortable with open access system than close-access system.

## **9. Suggestions**

Some of the suggestions for improving college library services in Golaghat District are given below.

1. The collection of the libraries should be enhanced.
2. The number of reference collection should be extended
3. There should be more subscription of journals.
4. The staff should be well acquainted with the latest technology.
5. The users' feedback should maintain in the college library.
